





Remove Chrome Address Auto-Fill

To deactivate the address autofill in Chrome, follow the steps below.

Step	Action
1	Open the Chrome browser.
2	<p>Click the  in the top right corner of the window and select Settings from the dropdown.</p> 
3	<p>Scroll down to the Autofill section and select Addresses and more.</p>
